

The Convictions That Shape Our Network

1. We believe that Jesus is Lord and the Church belongs to Him

We believe healthy churches reproduce disciples, leaders, ministries, and congregations. The call of the Church is not only to gather people, but also to send people.

- and collaborative kingdom partnerships.

We believe multiplication is not reserved for large churches but is part of the calling of every church willing to live missionally.

6. We believe that every believer is called and sent

Every follower of Jesus is gifted by the Holy Spirit and called into ministry and mission. We reject a consumer Christianity that fails to affirm the priesthood of all believers.

The Church flourishes when ordinary people are equipped, empowered, and released to live as missionaries in everyday life.
